Common name	Description	Botanical name
Arrowhead plant	Trailing vine. Low light ok.	<i>Syngonium podophyllum (Nephtytis)</i>
Corn plant	Upright, tall, narrow. Bright light.	<i>Dracaena fragrans 'Massangeana'</i>
Croton	Bushy. Bright light.	<i>Codiaeum variegatum</i>
Dragon tree	Upright, tall, narrow. Bright light.	<i>Dracaena marginata</i>
Dumb cane	Leafy, upright. No direct sun. Low light ok.	<i>Dieffenbachia species</i>
Easy ZZ	Leafy, upright. Tolerates very low light, drought.	<i>Zamioculcas zamiifolia</i>
Fiddleleaf fig	Bushy tree. Medium to bright light.	<i>Ficus lyrata</i>
Ivy, English ivy	Trailing/climbing vine. Low light ok. Ok outdoors.	<i>Hedera helix</i>
Janet Craig dracaena	Upright, tall, narrow. Bright light.	<i>Dracaena fragrans 'Janet Craig' (D. deremensis)</i>
Peace lily	Leafy; white flowers. Medium to bright light.	<i>Spathiphyllum</i>
Peperomia	Succulent, small. Medium to bright light. Keep dry.	<i>Peperomia clusiaefolia 'Jely'</i>
Philodendron pole	Trailing/climbing vine. Low light ok.	<i>Philodendron hastatum</i>
Pothos	Trailing/climbing vine. Low light ok.	<i>Epipremnum pinnatum (Scindapsus)</i>
Queensland umbrella tree	Upright tree, very narrow. Bright light.	<i>Schefflera actinophylla 'Alpine Jr'™</i>
Rubber plant	Bushy tree. Medium to bright light.	<i>Ficus elastica</i>
Snake plant	Stiff-leaved succulent. Very tolerant of drought, low light.	<i>Sansevieria trifasciata</i>
Spider plant	Leafy with trailing flower stems that sprout new plants. Medium to bright light. Ok outdoors.	<i>Chlorophytum comosum</i>
Split-leaf philodendron	Climbing vine. Tolerates low light.	<i>Monstera deliciosa</i>
Swedish ivy	Leafy trailing plant. Medium to bright light. Tolerates drought. Ok outdoors.	<i>Plectranthus verticillatus</i>
Tahitian bridal veil	Leafy trailing plant. Medium to bright light. Tolerates drought. Ok outdoors.	<i>Gibasis pellucida (Tradescantia)</i>
Wandering Jew	Leafy trailing plant Medium to bright light. Tolerates drought.	<i>Tradescantia zebrina</i>
Weeping fig	Upright tree. Medium to bright light. Prefers to be kept dry.	<i>Ficus benjamina</i>
