<i>Acer griseum</i>	paperbark maple	leaf scorch
<i>Acer japonicum</i>	halfmoon maple	leaf scorch; nice garden tree when irrigated in light shade.
<i>Acer palmatum</i>	Japanese maple	leaf scorch; nice garden tree when irrigated in light shade.
<i>Acer platanoides</i>	Norway maple	leaf scorch, bark sunburn
<i>Acer rubrum</i>	red maple	leaf scorch, bark sunburn
<i>Acer saccharinum</i>	silver maple	leaf scorch, bark sunburn
<i>Ailanthus altissima</i>	tree of heaven	invasive
<i>Albizia julibrissin</i>	silk tree	invasive
<i>Allocasuarina verticillata</i> ( <i>Casuarina stricta</i> )	coast beefwood	invasive
<i>Alnus rhombifolia</i>	California white alder	borers
<i>Araucaria araucana</i>	monkey puzzle tree	very large cones are a risk when they fall from mature trees
<i>Araucaria bidwillii</i>	bunya-bunya	very large cones are a risk when they fall from mature trees
<i>Araucaria heterophylla</i>	Norfolk Island pine	not hardy
<i>Arbutus menziesii</i>	madrone	crown/root rot
<i>Arctostaphylos manzanita</i> cvs.	manzanita	crown/root rot
<i>Betula pendula</i>	European white birch	borers, high water; nice garden tree when irrigated.
<i>Carya illinoensis</i>	pecan	aphids; beautiful big shade tree
<i>Cassia leptophylla</i>	gold medallion tree	not hardy
<i>Casuarina cunninghamiana</i>	river she-oak	invasive
<i>Catalpa bignonioides</i>	bean tree	invasive
<i>Catalpa speciosa</i>	western catalpa	breaks
<i>Ceanothus</i> species	wild lilac	crown/root rot
<i>Celtis sinensis</i>	Chinese hackberry	host-specific aphid
<i>Cercis canadensis</i>	eastern redbud	leaf scorch
<i>Cornus florida</i>	eastern dogwood	leaf scorch
<i>Cornus kousa</i>	Japanese dogwood	leaf scorch
<i>Crataegus</i> spp.	hawthorn	fireblight, suckers, litter. <i>C. phaenopyrum</i> , fireblight resistant, is very thorny.
<i>Elaeagnus angustifolia</i>	Russian olive	invasive
<i>Eriobotrya deflexa</i>	bronze loquat	fireblight
<i>Eriobotrya japonica</i>	loquat	fireblight, fruit litter; fine backyard tree grown for fruit.
<i>Erythrina crista-galli</i>	cockspur coral tree	not hardy when young but there have been established ones in the area.
<i>Erythrina x bidwillii</i>	Bidwell's coral bean	not hardy when young but there are established ones in the area.
<i>Eucalyptus camaldulensis</i>	red gum	breaks
<i>Eucalyptus globulus</i>	blue gum	breaks
<i>Eucalyptus gunnii</i>	cider gum	breaks
<i>Eucalyptus polyanthemos</i>	silver dollar gum	breaks
<i>Eucalyptus sideroxylon</i>	red iron bark	breaks
<i>Fraxinus</i> species	ash trees	borers
<i>Geijera parviflora</i>	Australian willow	not hardy
<i>Gleditsia triacanthos inermis</i>	honey locust	gall midge causes leaf drop in summer
<i>Grevillea robusta</i>	silk oak	breaks, litter (spiky leaves)
<i>Hesperocyparis (Cupressus) macrocarpa</i>	Monterey cypress	disease kills them
<i>Jacaranda mimosifolia</i>	jacaranda	not hardy when young but there are established ones in the area.
<i>Juglans regia</i>	English walnut	borers/disease

<i>Koelreuteria paniculata</i>	golden rain tree	invasive
<i>Laburnum x watereri</i>	golden chain tree	toxicity, heat stress
<i>Leptospermum laevigatum</i>	Australian tea tree	not hardy
<i>Ligustrum lucidum</i>	glossy privet	invasive
<i>Liquidambar styraciflua</i>	sweet gum	litter, roots
<i>Magnolia grandiflora</i>	southern magnolia	leaf scorch; nice garden tree when irrigated.
<i>Magnolia hybrids, dec</i>	hybrid magnolias	leaf scorch; nice garden tree when irrigated.
<i>Malus hybrids</i>	crabapples	fireblight, suckers, litter; nice garden tree when irrigated.
<i>Maytenus boaria</i>	mayten tree	disease
<i>Metasequoia glyptostroboides</i>	dawn redwood	high water need; nice garden tree when irrigated.
<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	sour gum, tupelo	water quality, litter
<i>Paulownia tomentosa</i>	empress tree	breaks
<i>Photinia serratifolia (P. serrulata)</i>	Chinese photinia	fireblight
<i>Picea abies</i>	Norway spruce	heat stress
<i>Picea glauca</i>	Alberta spruce	heat stress
<i>Picea pungens</i>	Colorado spruce	heat stress
<i>Pinus sabiniana</i>	foothill pine	very large cones are a risk when they fall from mature trees
<i>Populus fremontii</i>	Western Cottonwood	bอร์ส, aggressive roots, suckers. A beautiful tree in rural settings.
<i>Populus nigra "Italica"</i>	Lombardy poplar	bอร์ส, aggressive roots, suckers
<i>Prunus cerasifera</i> cultivars	Redleaf plum	fruit litter, suckers; nice garden tree when irrigated.
<i>Prunus serrulata, subhirtella</i>	flowering cherries	drainage, bอร์ส, bark sunburn; nice garden tree when irrigated.
<i>Pseudotsuga menziesii</i>	Douglas fir	heat stress
<i>Pyrus calleryana</i> cultivars	Callery pear	fireblight, invasive, breaks. Several cultivars, all have problems.
<i>Pyrus kawakamii</i>	evg pear	fireblight, leaf spots; nice garden tree when trained properly
<i>Rhus typhina</i>	staghorn sumac	invasive
<i>Robinia pseudoacacia</i>	black locust	breaks
<i>Robinia x ambigua</i>	locust	breaks
<i>Salix species</i>	willows	bอร์ס, breaks, aggressive roots, suckers, high water
<i>Searsia lancea (Rhus lancea)</i>	African sumac	litter, suckers
<i>Sequoia sempervirens</i>	coast redwood	high water need; nice garden tree when irrigated.
<i>Sequoiadendron giganteum</i>	giant sequoia	disease kills them
<i>Sorbus aucuparia</i>	European mountain ash	heat stress
<i>Styphnolobium japonicum (Sophora japonica)</i>	Japanese pagoda tree	litter (sticky pods)
<i>Tamarix aphylla</i>	salt cedar	invasive
<i>Taxodium distichum</i>	bald cypress	high water need; nice garden tree when irrigated.
<i>Tilia cordata</i>	little leaf linden	aphids; nice garden tree when irrigated.
<i>Triadica sebifera (Sapium sebiferum)</i>	Chinese tallow tree	invasive, surface roots, litter
